Just Eve

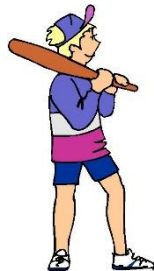

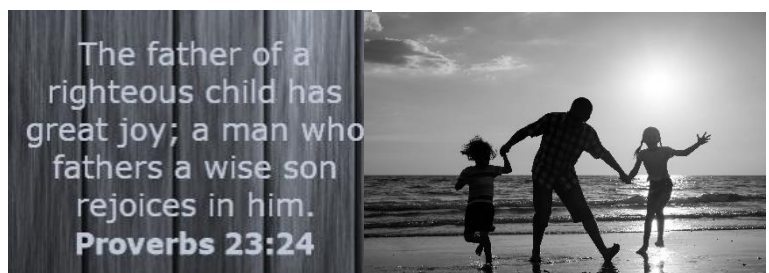
